HORSE ACTIVITIES

- Opportunity to ride various types of horses
- Learn to properly lunge a horse: as well as why certain equipment is used and how to use the equipment properly
- Practice exercises to strengthen riding ability
- Set a proper Hunter and Jumper course
- Set up learning exercises and what exercises will help certain areas of weakness.

The undersigned acknowledges that there are dangers and risks of injury inherent in these equestrian activities, but still desires to participate in these activities.

THEREFORE, the undersigned, for and in consideration of the opportunity to participate in these equestrian activities and for other good and valuable consideration, does hereby forever release, acquit and forever discharge AliBoo Farm, Inc. (and Janet A. Flury, John S. Bali, Alison L. Flury Taylor A. Flury) and its employees, agents and all other persons, corporations, associations, or partnerships from any and all claims, actions, causes of action, demands, rights, damages, costs, loss of service, expenses and compensation whatsoever which the undersigned has incurred or may hereinafter incur on account of, or in any way growing out of, any and all known or unknown, foreseen or unforeseen bodily and personal injuries and/or property damage or the consequences thereof resulting from any accident, casualty or event involving the undersigned and arising out of equestrian activities, regardless of fault.

FURTHERMORE, the undersigned, and his or her heirs, executors and administrators, shall forever refrain from instituting, prosecuting, or in any way aiding in the institution or prosecution of any claim, demand, action or course of action against AliBoo Farm, Inc. Flury) has no insurance covering equestrian activities and that the undersigned would not be permitted to engage in equestrian activities without this release whereby the undersigned, regardless of fault, agrees to fully release AliBoo Farm, Inc. (and Janet A. Flury, John S. Bali, Alison L. Flury and Taylor A. Flury) and its employees and agents from any and all responsibility as a result of accident or injury.

FURTHER, AND BY WAY OF INDEMNITY, the undersigned hereby expressly understands and agrees to indemnify and hold harmless AliBoo Farm, Inc. (and Janet A. Flury, John S. Bali, Alison L. Flury and Taylor A. Flury) and its employees and agents against any and all further claims or damages, costs or expenses incurred by AliBoo Farm, Inc. (and Janet A. Flury, John S. Bali, Alison L.
